6. MALAYSIAN CONGRESS OF RADIOLOGY (MCOR 2022)

The Malaysian Congress of Radiology 2022 (MCOR 2022) was held in the UNESCO city of Georgetown, Penang, from the 7th to the 9th of December, 2022. It was jointly organised by the College of Radiology (CoR) and the Malaysian Society of Radiology (MyRAD).

The theme was “Precision Imaging: Beyond Pixels and Positrons”.

A total of 257 Malaysian radiologists, trainees, and 16 international radiologists joined MCOR 2022 in person at Ascott Gurney Penang. MCOR 2022 received 239 abstracts, of which 21 were presented as oral presentations and 135 as e-poster panels. Seventy-two of these abstracts

accepted the opportunity to have their abstracts published in a supplementary JUMMEC. There was a total of 13 sessions and 41 presentations.

For the first time in MCOR history, there was a specially curated 1-day programme for Radiology Trainees to help them prepare for their exams. This session was called RadExam Prep and was led by Assoc Prof Dr Thajunnisa Hassan Mohd with her committee of experienced examiners and professors. RadExam Prep Part 1 was for medical officers recently passed the Medex and Entrance Examinations in December 2022 and covered MCQ, OSCE, OSPE and viva voce. RadExam Prep Part 2 catered for year 3 trainees preparing for viva voce and SBA (Single Best Answer). This will continue to be a feature for future MCORs.

MCOR is also a platform to strengthen the relationship and collaboration between Malaysian and international radiology societies. MCOR 2022 sent out a total of 9 invitations to neighbouring countries. Assoc Prof Dr Wiwatana Tanomkiat, President of the Royal College of Radiologists of Thailand and Dr Chum Soheat, member of the Cambodian Society of Radiology to Malaysia, accepted the invitation and attended MCOR 2022. It was an excellent opportunity to catch up with international colleagues since the pandemic began. It turned out well, where friendship and networking were formed again through face-to-face meetings.

No MCOR would be complete without the prestigious CoR-Dato' Samad Quiz. Dato' Dr Abdul Samad Sakijan was the effervescent Quiz Master.

Activities July 2022 to 24th June 2023

Breast Imaging Webinar

This webinar was held on 1st October 2022, from 2.00 pm - 6.00 pm. The objective of this half-day seminar is to enhance the knowledge and update Radiologists with new technology

in the field of Breast Imaging, mainly related to Breast Augmentation, such as: Overview of Techniques and protocol in imaging of breast implants, Challenges in managing complications from augmentation with Fillers and Personalised Treatment in Breast Cancer. The other topics included Pregnancy-associated breast cancers and Breast lesion Localizer Wireless Guidance

1. Malaysian Congress of Radiology (MCOR 2022)

There was a dedicated one hour session for the Special Interest Group in Breast Imaging, focusing on lectures and sharing the latest updates and developments in the clinical application of AI in Mammography and ABUS with an interesting case discussion session.

2. LPPKN (Lembaga Penduduk & Pembangunan Keluarga Negara)

Auditing of Mammographic Quality

The committee aims to ensure the quality of mammogram films done by the private centres meets the PGMI criteria and Phantom analysis meets the required standard. From June 2022 till present, 5 sessions of auditing were performed to assess if the required standards were met.

3. Pink October Breast Cancer Awareness Programme

The Breast group under the Breast Health Programme usually provide Mammogram services for the less privileged women in October. The Objective of the Pink Ribbon Programme is to provide a complete work up for underprivileged ladies in breast screening and to create awareness among the public regarding their health on early breast cancer detection. About 700 Estee Lauder vouchers were given of which 450 sets were for the state of Sarawak and 250 sets for the state of Pahang. However, we hope to be able to carry out this programme on a large scale in the coming month of October 2023.

Hoping that the way moving forward is through collaboration with City Cancer Challenge Foundation; we can have frequent multidisciplinary Zoom meetings both locally and internationally where we can collectively plan and implement cancer solutions based on individual needs.
